

# HDSA Block Ambassador

Our **Block Ambassador** role a very important conduit from our merchant community to our Executive Director. Block Ambassadors spend time visiting assigned merchants every 4-6 weeks (approx. 90 minutes), checking-in with an HDSA supplied postcard (what's happening, upcoming events, reminders), and a chat about what's going well, and opportunities for improvements. Anything business critical is reported back to our Executive Director in an online form following your visit.

This volunteer position is a longer term time commitment and very rewarding. A great opportunity to connect with local merchants and learn more about small businesses in the area.

Historic Downtown Snohomish Association (HDSA) is fortunate to have community members like you to donate your time and expertise to keep our traditions and community thriving. Without your support, so much of what we do would not be possible!

# Corporate Matching, cont'd Thanks for your support!

### Microsoft

- Financial donations: Microsoft matches each employee's donations of money, products, and time to nonprofits, up to \$15,000 a year.
- Volunteer time: The match of volunteer time is \$25 per hour that an employee volunteers.
- HDSA has been confirmed in the system and approved for matching.

### **Starbucks**

- Financial donations: You may request a Starbucks Giving Match for your financial donations to qualified non-profit organizations.
- Volunteer time: You may request a Starbucks Giving Match for your individual community service hours at qualified non-profit organizations.

### Boeing

- Financial donations: Boeing matches employees' contributions 100% when they donate at least \$25 to an eligible organization.
- Volunteer time: Boeing will donate \$100 to an eligible organization when a employee volunteers there for at least 10 hours.


