

Who is HDSA


- Stewards of the downtown district



What is MSTCTP!

Main Street Tax Credit Incentive Program

- An opportunity for you to use your donation as a tax credit
- For anyone who contributes to B&O Taxes
- Gives you the power to delegate where your tax dollars go (right back into your own community)
- Only an accredited program in WA state can receive your funds
- You receive 75% of your donation as a B&O tax credit
- HDSA as a 501c3 makes your contribution deductible on your Federal Tax (confirm with your CPA)
- Great alternative or addition to sponsorships that rewards you with a double tax credit

How it works Timeline

Jar

- Visit the WA DOR website and pledge your donation to HDSA
- HDSA is notified of your pledge
- We invoice you
 - Lump sum
 - Monthly
 - Quarterly

Example: You estimate paying \$1000 of B&O taxes in 2024. You pledge \$1000 to HDSA and pay the B&O taxes you owe throughout the year

How it works Timeline



- Pay invoices to HDSA
- Assess sales against pledge
- You can adjust your pledge if needed
- Refunds aren't available (you cannot apply credits for more than you owe in taxes)

Example: HDSA invoices you in Jan, April, July, and October for \$250.00 each

How it works Timeline



- You have paid your donation to HDSA in full
- HDSA reports your payments to WSMSP
- WSMSP reports to DOR
- Apply your credit when you pay your B&O taxes the next year

Example: HDSA reports your contribution of \$1000. In 2025, your B&O taxes are reduced to \$250 with your 75% credit

The Payoff

- You have received a \$750 credit for your 2025 B&O taxes, reducing your estimated payment from \$1000 to \$250
- You have allocated funds into your own community that would normally go into a general tax "bucket" (aka Olympia)
- You have earned yourself a federal tax write off in addition to your B&O tax credit, doubling your donation benefit
- You may have reduced your taxable income down to a lower bracket (not always the case but sometimes a huge win!!)




Options moving forward




Options moving forward

Assess and pledge more to HDSA in 2025 Incur additional tax credits for 2026 Empower the work of downtown preservation Increase your additional federal tax write off





Options moving forward

Take the credit as extra \$\$...

Maybe you need extra money in the next year Only pay 25% of your owed B&O by using your credit and not pledging to HDSA for 2025 Eliminates any credits in 2026 Reduces your federal tax deduction Bums HDSA out but we understand
